Memorandum of Agreement

1. The National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association agrees:

- A. To permit the use of the prefix "U.S." in connection with the terms used in describing, advertising, and selling hatching eggs, chicks, and breeding stock of various classes of the National Poultry Improvement Plan when the proper quality is attained and when satisfied that proper compliance has been made to all rules and regulations of the National Poultry Improvement Plan and the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association.
- B. To direct and supervise work done relative to flock selection in the various breeding stages, testing for PT disease and hatchery operation as provided for in the National Poultry Improvement Plan.
- C. To conduct the inspection work called for in the National Poultry Improvement Plan.
- D. To report to the Veterinary Service Division of USDA, any member of the poultry industry participating in, but not complying with all provisions of the National Poultry Improvement Plan.

2. The breeder, hatcheryman, or dealer agrees:

- A. To comply with the requirements of the above-named phases of the National Poultry Improvement Plan and rules and regulations of the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association.
- B. That before any action is taken or caused to be taken by the cooperating breeder or hatcheryman against the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association or any of its members or employees, the cooperating breeder or hatcheryman present a written statement of his or her complaint to the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Division within 30 days before such action will be taken.

3. Revocation of Agreement

- A. This agreement may be revoked by the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association for any violation pertaining to the National Poultry Improvement Plan. In case of revocation, the hatchery or farm owner or manager agrees to forfeit all fees paid to the Official State Agency. All rights and benefits of participation in the National Poultry Improvement Plan shall be forfeited until compliance can be proven in accordance with the provisions outlined in the Title 9 CFR. Upon revocation of this agreement, the Official State Agency is authorized to notify any or all cooperators in the National Poultry Improvement Plan of the revocation.
- B. This agreement may also be revoked by the participant by providing a written statement to the National Plans Division of the North Central Poultry Association.
